Colourful occasion for the oldest and most senior British Order of Chivalry, founded by King Edward III in 1348. After lunch the King and 24 knights walk to St George's Chapel, wearing traditional ceremonial robes and hats, and after the service return to the Castle's upper ward in an open-carriage procession. A national institution and highlight of the British social calendar which combines tradition, fashion, pageantry, dining, and style.
