

Day 1:

- Morning** Spend the morning discovering [Windsor Castle](#)
- 1pm - 2pm** Explore the Shops in Windsor and grab some lunch in one of the [many restaurants or pubs](#) in Windsor.
- 2pm - 4pm** Explore the rest of Windsor & Eton with a [City Sightseeing Open Top Bus Tour](#), the tour takes around 45 minutes but as the tour is hop on – hop off you can get off the bus if you spot something you fancy. Why not combine your Bus Tour ticket with a [French Brothers 40 minute Boat Ride](#)?
- Evening** Enjoy your evening with dinner at one of the many town centre [restaurants](#), a nighttime ride on the [Royal Windsor Wheel](#) (seasonal) or a production at the [Theatre Royal](#).

Day 2:

- Morning** Start the day with a short stroll around the Guildhall and cobbled Castle Hill. Watch the [Changing of the Guard](#) at 10.45am but remember to confirm times at the Royal Windsor Information Centre.
- 12pm - 1pm** Discover the beautiful [Savill Garden](#), part of the Windsor Great Park. With over 35 acres of trees and shrubbery, ponds and streams and flowers all year round the Garden is a incredible visit all year round. Grab lunch at the fantastic restaurant before heading back to Windsor.
- 3pm - 5pm** Enjoy a [Guided Tour of Eton College](#), founded in 1440 by Henry VI it has become one of the most exclusive schools in the world- the ancient desks and benches still bear the graffiti of generations of former pupils!
- 5:15 pm** End your visit to Windsor where it began with [Evensong at St. George`s Chapel](#) in Windsor Castle. As the chapel of Windsor Castle St George`s is one of the most beautiful ecclesiastical buildings in England and the burial place of ten monarchs including Henry VIII.
