

Day 1:

10:00am – 01:00 pm [Windsor Castle](#) -discover the castle with an audio-guide, allow 2 ½ to 3 hours, there is a special children’s audio tour in English.

01:00 pm – 02:00 pm Have **lunch** in one of the many [restaurants or pubs](#) in Windsor (if you wish to re-enter the Castle later on you can get a wristband before leaving, at the exit)

03:00 pm – 04:00 pm [Boat Trip on the River Thames](#) and feed the swans on the River Thames.

Or: Soar over 50 metres into the skies above historic Windsor - go on the giant [Windsor Wheel](#) at Alexandra Gardens and enjoy spectacular panoramic views.

04:00 pm – 06:00 pm [Windsor Leisure Centre](#) (swimming pool with waves, slides and Jacuzzis ; open until 06:15 pm to 09:30 pm, depending on day of the week)

10:00am – 05:00 pm [Legoland® Windsor](#). Hands-on entertainment for children aged 2-12, over 50 interactive rides, live shows, building workshops, driving schools and attractions set in 150 acres of beautiful parkland (shuttle bus available from Windsor)
